- Tourism has been boosted by the availability of high speed Internet access, as techies from the Bay area and elsewhere consider Ashland an ideal mixture of beauty and technology.


- Free wireless Internet access is much more available and widespread here than just about anywhere else in the country.


Michael Betzina (center) demonstrates Open Door's Envision software to potential users.
